

**Dr hab. Seweryn Mroczek prof. ucz.**

Seweryn Mroczek is an Assistant Professor at the University of Warsaw and a Staff Scientist at the International Institute of Molecular and Cell Biology (IIMCB). His research focuses on the post-transcriptional regulation of gene expression in metazoans, particularly the turnover mechanisms of endogenous and therapeutic mRNA. To gain insight into these processes, he combines functional studies using various biological models — primarily transgenic animal models — with cutting-edge molecular biology techniques.

He has published in several leading scientific journals, including Nature, Nature Communications, Science Advances, Genes & Development, NAR, or the EMBO Journal. He has been awarded the START Fellowship from the Foundation for Polish Science and the Scholarship for Outstanding Young Scientists from the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education.
