

Dr hab. Seweryn Mroczek prof. ucz.

Seweryn Mroczek is an Assistant Professor at the University of Warsaw and a Staff Scientist at the International Institute of Molecular and Cell Biology (IIMCB). His research focuses on the post-transcriptional regulation of gene expression in metazoans, particularly the turnover mechanisms of endogenous and therapeutic mRNA. To gain insight into these processes, he combines functional studies using various biological models — primarily transgenic animal models — with cutting-edge molecular biology techniques.

He has published in several leading scientific journals, including *Nature*, *Nature Communications*, *Science Advances*, *Genes & Development*, *NAR*, or the *EMBO Journal*. He has been awarded the START Fellowship from the Foundation for Polish Science and the Scholarship for Outstanding Young Scientists from the Polish Ministry of Science and Higher Education.
